

FUN FACTS

Although all 300 examples of the 1953 Corvette were fitted with two hood-release latches (one on each side of the cockpit), Chevrolet sought to simplify the mechanism in 1954 with a single latch. That said, the two-part 1953 style latches were installed on approximately the first 500 1954 models before the single latch was phased in.

In 1955, changes were made to the material used to make the folding top. Vinyl-coated fabric replaced the canvas used in 1953-1954, and some early 1955 bodies. Softer and less prone to wrinkles, the vinyl-impregnated material was part of an industry wide trend away from the more utilitarian canvas.

The third Motorama Corvette offering for 1594 was a roadster fitted with a removable fiberglass hardtop and roll-up door glass, details that would not appear in regular production until the 1956 model year. Until then, all Corvette roadsters had awkward snap-in side windows and manually operated folding soft tops.
